## **SPRING BURRATA SALAD**

### **EXECUTIVE CHEF DANIEL HOHNG**

This vibrant spring burrata salad is a fresh and elegant way to celebrate the season's finest ingredients. Light yet indulgent, it's perfect for a leisurely lunch or as a stunning start to any meal.

### INGREDIENTS:

For The Salad

- 6 cups arugula
- 2 cups sugar snap peas
- 11/2 cups frozen edamame
- 1/2 cup thinly sliced leeks
- 2 cups shaved or thinly sliced cucumbers
- 1/2 pound burrata cheese
- 2 teaspoons chopped fresh dill

For The Vinaigrette

- 2/3 cup olive oil
- 1/3 cup lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon chopped fresh dill
- salt, to taste.
- black pepper to taste

### COOKING INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. Blanch the Vegetables

Bring a medium saucepan of water to a boil. Prepare a large bowl of ice water. Blanch the snap peas for 1-2 minutes, then remove with a slotted spoon. Next,

blanch the edamame for 4–5 minutes. Quickly drain both and transfer to the ice bath to cool. Drain again and pat dry.

### 2. Assemble the Salad

Spread the arugula across a serving platter. Arrange the snap peas, edamame, cucumber, and leeks evenly over the greens. Gently tear the burrata and scatter the pieces on top.

### 3. Dress & Serve

Drizzle generously with lemon vinaigrette, then sprinkle with fresh dill, salt, and pepper. Serve immediately. This salad pairs beautifully with a crisp white wine and makes an excellent appetizer or light meal. Enjoy!

### **Recommended Wine Pairing**

Dr. Hermann Piesporter Goldtröpfchen Riesling, Mosel, Germany – A perfect pairing for this light spring dish.

Far Niente Chardonnay, Napa Valley - A great choice for those who prefer a full-bodied white wine.






